

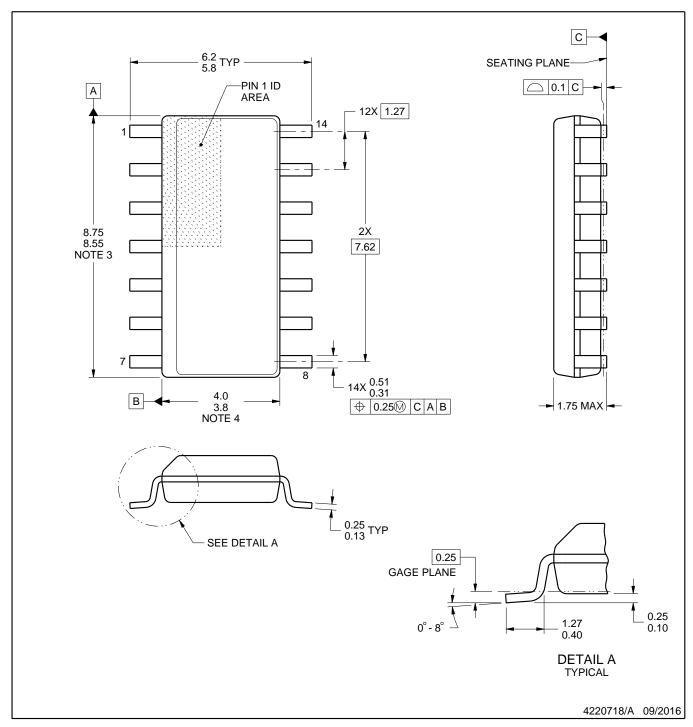

SMALL OUTLINE INTEGRATED CIRCUIT



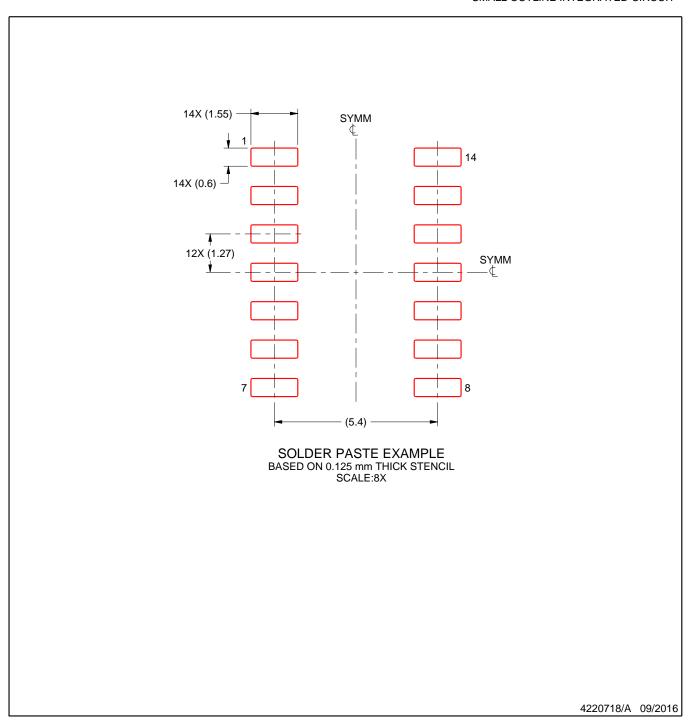
