# MC3486 Quadruple Differential Line Receiver with 3-State Outputs

### 3 Description

The MC3486 is a monolithic quadruple differential line receiver designed to meet the specifications of ANSI Standards TIA/EIA-422-B and TIA/EIA-423-B and ITU Recommendations V.10 and V.11. The MC3486 offers four independent differential-input line receivers that have TTL-compatible outputs. The outputs utilize 3state circuitry to provide a high-impedance state at any output when the appropriate output enable is at a low logic level.


The MC3486 is designed for optimum performance when used with the MC3487 quadruple differential line driver. It is supplied in a 16-pin package and operates from a single 5-V supply.

The MC3486 is characterized for operation from 0°C to 70°C.




Figure 4-1. D, N, or NS Package (Top View)






Figure 6-1. V<sub>OH</sub>, V<sub>OL</sub>




Figure 7-1. Schematics of Inputs and Outputs
