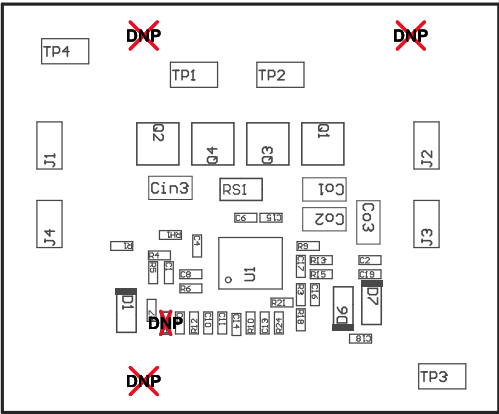
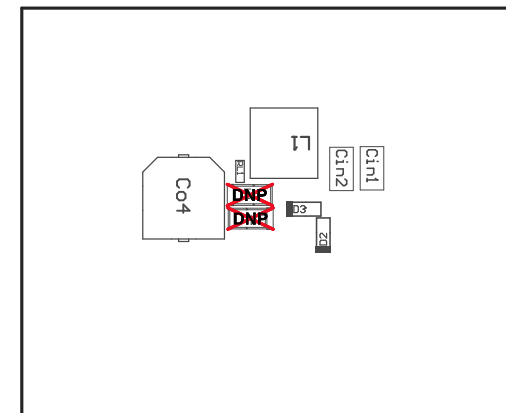


- ZZ1 ■ These assemblies are ESD sensitive, ESD precautions shall be observed.
