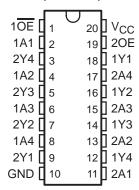
#### description

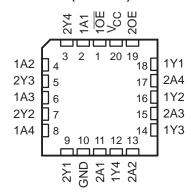

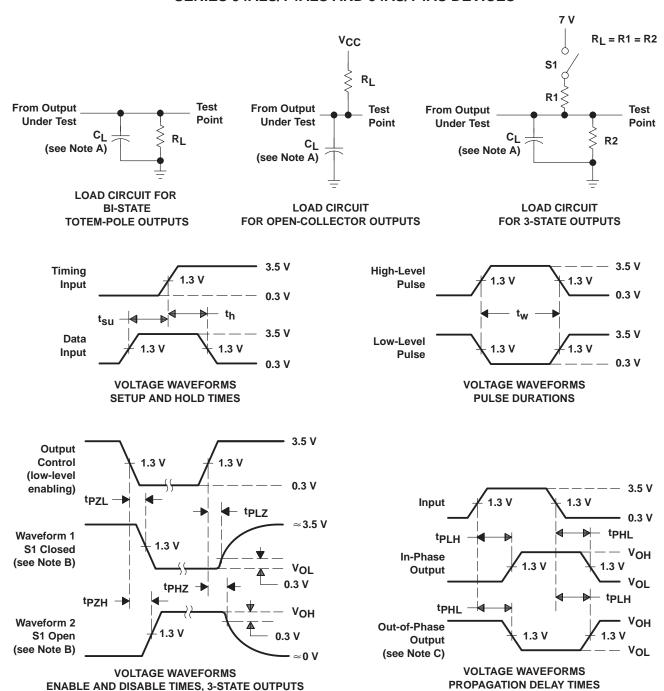
