



When employed with high-speed memories utilizing a fast-enable circuit, the delay times of these decoders and the enable time of the memory are usually less than the typical access time of the memory. Therefore, the effective system delay introduced by the Schottky-clamped system decoder is negligible.

The 'ALS139 comprise two individual 2-line to 4-line decoders in a single package. The active-low enable (\overline{G}) input can be used as a data line in demultiplexing applications. These






